**IMPORTANT:**

1. **Veterans** – Veteran's points will be awarded in accordance with the Connecticut State Statute. Five (5) for non-disabled veterans, ten (10) for disabled veterans. Proper documentation must be submitted to the Personnel Director before the date of the examination.
2. **Residents** – Residency points shall be added in accordance with the amendment to the Civil Service Rules and Regulations. Proper documentation (Civil Service Office Request for Residency Points) must be submitted with application of employment. **THIS POSITION IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR RESIDENCY POINTS.**

**EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:** Participates in the field work in promotion of general environmental health programs and performs the associated routine technical work of moderate difficulty; investigates complaints of substandard, unsanitary conditions in dwellings, alleys, vacant lots or business establishments; inspects transient lodging and trailer camps for overcrowding, defective plumbing, fire hazards, and related undesirable conditions and recommends corrective measures to be followed; investigates requests for permits to occupy basement rooms in houses; investigates complaints of nuisances, such as rats, flies, mosquitoes, weeds, unsanitary privies, and refuse disposal and recommends control measures; appears in court as witness against persons in violation of health codes; enforces ordinances pertaining to control of rat and insect infestation; checks operators; licenses and renews or suspends permits; inspects restaurants, groceries, bakeries and other food establishments for cleanliness of personnel, utensils and storage facilities; instructs restaurant proprietors on the proper location of sanitary facilities and makes periodic inspections for compliance; recommends revocation of health permits and appears as a witness in court against violators of sanitary laws; does related work as required.

**REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:** Good knowledge of public health and sanitation practices and ordinances; good knowledge of the philosophy and principles underlying modern environmental sanitation programs; good observation; ability to be tactful yet firm in enforcing compliance with laws and ordinances; thoroughness; dependability; good physical condition.

**IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THIS POSITION YOU MUST INDICATE ON YOUR APPLICATION THAT AS OF THE CLOSING DATE YOU HAVE THE FOLLOWING EXPERIENCE:** Minimum nine months-experience as a Sanitarian I and graduation from an accredited 4-year college or university program with major course work in science or related field.

**ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT:** Must hold a valid State of Connecticut Sanitarian License to inspect food establishments, or be eligible for licensure within the probationary period.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:** Must hold a valid Motor Vehicle Driver's License for job duties requiring use of privately owned vehicle.

**YOU MUST SUBMIT THE FOLLOWING WITH YOUR APPLICATION:**

- ◆ Department of Motor Vehicle Driver's History
- ◆ State of Connecticut Sanitarian License
- ◆ Copy of 4-year College Degree or Transcripts

This position is covered under the written agreement between the City of Waterbury and the White Collar Union. The Parts and Weights for this examination will be determined prior to conducting the exam. Individuals appointed shall be required to serve a working test period which will be, in effect, the final phase of the examination.

**APPEAL PROCESS:** An applicant may appeal a notice of rejection of his/her application to the Civil Service Commission within seven (7) days of receipt of such notice. Please notify the Civil Service Office of a change in address. Notification will be mailed to the address written on your application.
